3. [Génépi Editions](#) – A support solution for local authorities, offering practical guides developed in collaboration with residents based on their feedback, to help citizens at every stage of their lives.

4. [Hormur](#) – Hormur is a platform that facilitates cultural outreach by transforming

everyday spaces (homes, shops, businesses) into event venues.

5. [HotRiver](#) - HotRiver develops renewable energy solutions based on hydrothermal energy, harnessing the heat from rivers and lakes.

6. [Ouicycle - Les Roues Solidaires](#) - Ouicycle offers an inclusive active mobility solution for local authorities, facilitating travel and physical activity for older people and those with disabilities.
